Getting started

The Broadcast software will be preinstalled on Newline flat panels and, therefore, no installation of software is required. The Broadcast client is a webbased application, which requires a web browser.

Firewall rules


These ports must be allowed to give access for video streaming:

- TCP 80, 443, 3478, 5379, 19305 and 19307
- UDP 0-65535

Using Broadcast

Sharing your screen

A session is started by opening the Broadcast application and pressing the "Start broadcast" button.



Public share link

Each broadcast creates its own unique URL, which can be copied to the clipboard and shared with users.

Enlarge

Users can interact with the "Enlarge" option to enlarge the broadcast information. This is designed to help users view the broadcast information from afar.


Stop Broadcast

To end the Broadcast, press the Stop Broadcast button.

Viewing a Broadcast

Viewing a broadcast can be achieved by:

- 1. Clicking the link sent by the broadcast host.
- **2.** Going to broadcast.online, entering the 6-digit Broadcast ID and pressing Connect.
